

Re: FOLLOW-UP DEMAND FOR ACTION

District Attorney Summer Stephan,

You have said it yourself: Silence just allows the perpetrators to continue.

I am still here. My family is still here. Malaika and Xayah are still separated from us, and the damage is still continuing.

You are already on notice. I am not writing to retell more than two years of history. I am writing to remind you that the evidence still exists: recordings, videos, texts, reports, court records, medical records, sworn statements, witnesses, photographs, and a documented chronology showing contradictions, retaliation, and the continuing destruction of this family.

Our family is exposing what is happening as child trafficking under color of authority. Malaika and Xayah have a mother, father, grandparents, siblings, and extended family. They are not children without family. Yet they remain inside a publicly funded system while evidence of their bond, distress, and catastrophic psychological and emotional harm remains in plain sight.

The scrutiny must include both government actors and private individuals. No one involved in advancing false information, retaliation, concealment, obstruction, or other unlawful conduct should be protected from investigation simply because of a government title, legal position, or private-caregiver status.

Civil-rights counsel is involved. Evidence is being preserved. Broader federal action concerning abuses inside publicly funded child-welfare systems is being examined. I am not laying out strategy, timing, or the full scope of what is developing. Your office only needs to understand that this matter is not disappearing.

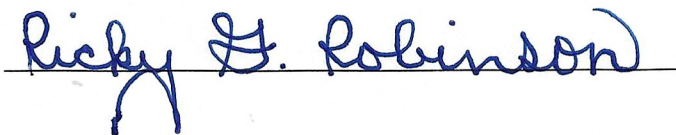
Preserve the evidence. Examine it independently. Follow the facts wherever they lead.

I am demanding immediate action to expose this grotesque miscarriage of justice, pursue every lawful avenue to overturn the wrongful termination, and bring Malaika and Xayah home.
