

Donald Trump Jr.,

I am writing because my granddaughters, Malaika and Xayah Robinson, have been separated from their family through a child-welfare case that became a campaign of retaliation after our family began exposing government misconduct.

This is no longer about protecting children. Malaika and Xayah have been used as leverage to punish their mother, father, grandfather, and every person who refused to remain silent. Their mother, Evelyn Lopez, completed the classes, counseling, therapy, and services demanded of her, but the requirements kept changing and reunification remained out of reach.

Our family spoke publicly before the San Diego County Board of Supervisors and through our website, podcasts, videos, flyers, and independent investigative reporting. After that public exposure, visits were restricted and ultimately taken away, family bonds were attacked, and official records increasingly portrayed me as dangerous. Yet the testimony against me repeatedly centered on my speech, photographs, blog, public criticism, and refusal to stop exposing the case—not violence or any actual danger to my granddaughters.

A neurotherapist testified for two days that Malaika and Xayah had a strong bond with their mother and that permanently severing that bond would cause catastrophic psychological and emotional harm. She also testified that social workers stopped documenting visits before the children's worst end-of-visit trauma began. Videos show the girls screaming, pulling their hair, and desperately crying for their family.

Evelyn is now safely and lovingly raising infant twins whom she has cared for continuously since birth, while Malaika and Xayah remain separated from her and have never been allowed to meet the twins. Their great-grandmother died at age 88 without ever being permitted to see the girls return home.

We possess recordings, messages, medical records, court documents, official reports, videos, witness testimony, and independent reporting. This evidence documents retaliation for protected speech, First and Fourteenth Amendment violations, profound violations of human dignity, and an orchestrated alignment between County actors and private caregivers that prolonged family separation instead of supporting safe reunification or approved family placement.

I am asking for serious help—not another referral back to the same local system. Please help bring this case before federal civil-rights attorneys, investigators, journalists, and officials willing to examine the evidence independently and hold those responsible accountable.

Photographs of Malaika, Xayah, and our family are enclosed. Please look at their faces and understand what has been done to these children and our entire family.

Please help us bring Malaika and Xayah home.
