This is a follow-up to the certified package I sent on July 22. I am an American senior citizen writing to you as another American who understands what family means and what it means to protect it.

What is happening to my family in San Diego County involves fraud, waste, and abuse carried out under color of law. Two young children, Malaika and Xayah, have family. Their mother completed services, and their grandfather was approved through the County's own process as a caregiver. Despite this, they remain separated from their family.

There is evidence supporting what I am saying, including recordings, documents, timelines, and witnesses. This case changed after it was exposed publicly. Following that exposure, the response was not correction but retaliation. Contact was restricted, allegations escalated, and pressure was applied to silence our family. A restraining order was then used to isolate an approved family member and caregiver from the children, and court actions were used to remove family support while maintaining separation.

This raises serious concerns under the First Amendment and the Fourteenth Amendment. Speaking out is being met with consequences instead of accountability, and family relationships are being severed despite the presence of approved relatives.

We want our children home. We want my grandchildren home. Their mother has twins who have never been allowed to meet their sisters, and their great-grandmother will never see them again. This is not temporary and not theoretical. This is a real family being separated in real time.

We are asking for federal attention to this matter. We are asking for an independent review outside the local system and accountability where authority and public resources are being misused. This is not an isolated situation, and others are beginning to speak out with similar concerns. The harm to these children is ongoing.

Please confirm receipt of this correspondence and advise what action will be taken.

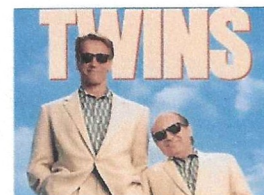
