

Senator Paul:

I am asking for your immediate help with one of the most extreme examples of child-welfare fraud, retaliation, case-fixing, false records, and coordinated abuse of government power ever directed against a family.

For more than two years, my granddaughters, Malaika and Xayah Robinson, have remained separated from their family that has fought relentlessly to bring them home. The official records repeatedly state that Malaika and Xayah were not abused or neglected. This case should have ended more than a year and a half ago. Instead, officials continued manufacturing allegations, manipulating records, extending litigation, and using government power to punish our family for exposing misconduct.

While Evelyn Lopez, Malaika and Xayah's mother, was in Missouri, California child-welfare workers and a private caregiver pressured her to return by threatening that the United States Marshals, Border Patrol, and other law-enforcement agencies would come after her. Missouri's Children's Division was contacted, and a worker named Jane stated that the circumstances did not meet the criteria for child abuse or neglect. Evelyn returned, turned herself in, and a breastfeeding mother was jailed for five days—causing her to miss her daughter's first birthday—before being released without criminal charges.

That did not end the attack. It intensified it.

Our family, advocates, journalists, investigative reporters, mandated reporters, and other professionals have been threatened, discredited, silenced, or targeted for exposing what is happening. Officials have used false reports, retaliatory restraining orders, courtroom power, and taxpayer-funded systems against anyone they do not want speaking publicly. They are continuing to isolate Malaika and Xayah from their family and inflict catastrophic psychological and emotional harm.

Under the guise of child protection, these officials are terrorizing families. Title IV-E funds and other public resources are being used to prolong family separation while millions of dollars continue flowing through a system that rewards unnecessary cases, placements, services, attorneys, contractors, and years of litigation. They are creating behavioral-health crises in the very children and families they claim to protect.

The evidence includes recordings, sworn statements, court records, medical records, text messages, agency reports, documented contradictions, retaliatory threats, and admissions left in plain sight. These officials act as though they are untouchable. They lie in official records, manufacture narratives, leave paper trails and recorded admissions, and carry out retaliation in broad daylight with no mercy, no empathy, and no fear of accountability.

My family has fought constantly for Malaika and Xayah. Independent investigators, advocates, journalists, and professionals have helped document and amplify our case. An elected school-board official also addressed the San Diego County Board of Supervisors twice, publicly calling attention to what is happening to Malaika and Xayah and urging action. My 88-year-old mother died during this ordeal without ever seeing her great-granddaughters returned to their family. The damage to Malaika, Xayah, their mother, and our entire family remains ongoing.

I am asking you to demand congressional oversight and an independent federal investigation outside San Diego County and outside California. The investigation must examine child-welfare fraud, misuse of federal funding, falsified and manipulated records, retaliation for protected speech, obstruction, coordinated abuse of authority, judge and forum shopping, and the use of restraining orders and courts to silence families and witnesses.

This case raises a basic question that government officials have avoided for far too long: How are bureaucrats getting away with carrying out this level of fraud, retaliation, and calculated harm against children and families?

Senator Paul, you have shown that you are willing to confront government overreach and demand accountability. I am asking you to bring that same resolve to what is happening to Malaika and Xayah Robinson and to the families being destroyed by a child-welfare system that believes it is above the law.
